

## EMATRIX SKIN REJUVENATION PRE AND POST TREATMENT INFORMATION

### POTENTIAL SIDE EFFECTS

- Provide your technician with an accurate and up-to-date medical history to receive a safe and effective treatment.
- Side effects are temporary and uncommon but may include erythema, swelling, temporary scarring, dryness, itching and burning.
- Clients who are pregnant or lactating may not receive eMatrix treatments.
- Clients who have taken Accutane within 6 months may not receive eMatrix treatments.
- Clients who are prone to cold sores should take an anti-viral medication prior to a facial eMatrix treatment.
- Clients with a pacemaker, internal defibrillator or any other active electrical implant anywhere in the body, may not receive eMatrix treatments.

### PRE-TREATMENT

Prior to the eMatrix treatment please observe the following:

- Avoid all alpha hydroxyl and beta hydroxyl products (AHA/BHA), Hydroquinone, retinols/retinoid, Tazorac and Differin 7 days prior to an eMatrix treatment.
- Avoid prolonged sun exposure to any areas that will be treated 7 days prior to treatment.
- Treatment will not be administered on sunburned skin.
- Avoid sunless tanning products on any areas that will be treated 7 days prior to treatment.
- If an active or extreme breakout occurs on the area to be treated before treatment, contact our office to reschedule.
- No chemical peels, laser hair removal or skin resurfacing treatments on any areas that will be treated for a minimum of two weeks or until complete healing has occurred.
- Clients with any abnormal lesions, moles or spots on the areas to be treated must be cleared by a medical practitioner prior to treatment.
- If you are prone to cold sores, take an anti-viral medication prior to treatment. Clients with active cold sores may not be treated.
- Clients who have used Accutane, or similar products within the past 6 months CANNOT have an eMatrix treatment.
- Clients who have had Botox or dermal fillers in the area that will be treated, need to wait 14 days before any eMatrix treatments.
- Clients with a pacemaker, internal defibrillator or any other active electrical implant anywhere in the body may not receive any eMatrix treatments.
- We do not treat over permanent makeup or tattoos.
- Cleanse treatment area and apply numbing cream 45 min to 1 hour prior to the eMatrix treatment.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING YOUR TREATMENT

- Your technician will cleanse your face and remove all numbing cream.
- Treatment time is approximately 30 min depending on the area that needs to be treated.
- You will feel pressure, a slight stinging, itching and a heat sensation. This is normal and will subside 1-2 hours after treatment.
- Immediately after your treatment you will look and feel as though you have a moderate to severe sunburn. Your skin may feel warm and tighter than usual. This is normal and will subside after 1 to 2 hours.
- Your technician will prescribe post-procedure skincare to soothe, calm and protect your skin.
